# bksbLIVE Reference Guide Completing assessments (for students)

Last updated 09 May 2016

#### Introduction

As part of your enrolment at RMIT University, you are required to complete a literacy (English) and numeracy (Maths) assessment using bksbLIVE. Completion of the English and Maths assessment may be used to:

- 1. Help us identify your educational support needs, and
- 2. Determine your eligibility for VET FEE- HELP.

The results of these assessments are <u>not</u> used as an entry requirement to your program. Please complete both of these assessments before attending your enrolment session.

#### Tips for Use

- It is recommended you complete these assessments on either a PC or Tablet device. The test is not designed for use on a mobile phone.
- Allow around 30 minutes to complete <u>each</u> assessment. You can take as long as you need to complete each assessment. You can choose to retake an assessment if desired.
- The assessment automatically saves after each answer, so you do not need to complete each assessment in one sitting.
- Take a break between tests.
- If you need technical assistance, please contact the <u>ITS Service Desk</u>. For all other queries, please contact <u>RMIT Connect</u>.

## Logging in to bksbLIVE

To login to bskbLIVE:

1. Open a web browser and visit <a href="http://RMIT.bksblive2.com.au">http://RMIT.bksblive2.com.au</a>

2. Enter your username and password, which can be found in your <u>guide to enrolment</u> under *Complete a pre-training review*.

**Note:** You will be prompted to change your password the first time you login to bksbLIVE. This change will only be recorded for bksbLIVE and will not be synchronised to other RMIT systems.

3. After login, you will be presented with the bksbLIVE home screen. This will display:

- a navigation menu,
- courses you are required to undertake,
- notifications (including your progress and messages from teachers), and
- a list of help topics.





### Completing your English assessment

You are required to complete the Initial Assessment for English. This could take between 20 and 40 minutes to complete, depending on your individual pace. **Note:** You are **not** required to complete the English Diagnostic Assessment.

To take the English Initial Assessment:
