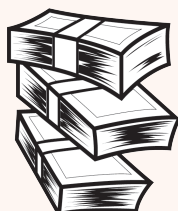

If you could dig a deep enough hole in China...

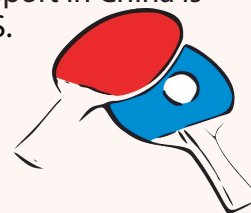


You'd end up in ARGENTINA or CHILE.
