INSTALLATION OF ISOLATION VALVES BUILDING 201 - BUNDOORA WEST CAMPUS

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Property Services will be installing water isolation valves in building 201 at RMIT Bundoora West campus.

REASON FOR WORKS

These works form part of the Sustainable Urban Precincts Program (SUPP) and will improve RMIT's energy usage associated with University operations at the Bundoora West campus. Property Services appreciate your assistance and patience whilst we work together towards a more sustainable RMIT.

AFFECTED SERVICES/AREAS

Property Services have engaged Honeywell as the Principal Contractor to manage these works and they have been instructed to ensure continuity of operations (where possible) is not compromised.

Domestic hot water supply to Food Science Laboratories on Level 5, the Animal House and the Anatomy Laboratories will be temporarily lost while the works are occurring. Heating and Cooling Conditions will only be affected in Anatomy Laboratories for the duration of the works. Conditions and domestic hot water will be fully operational before **06:00am Monday 7th November**.
