

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

AU\$5000 scholarships to study at RMIT University in Semester 2*

If you are an international student commencing an undergraduate or postgraduate program at RMIT's School of Computer Science and Information Technology (RMIT Melbourne city campus), this scholarship can pay a contribution towards your tuition fees.

Applications open: Monday 17 March 2014

Value and duration

The scholarship pays a one off payment of \$5000 towards your tuition fees for first fee installment after the payment of your deposit and once you have arrived and enrolled into your program.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship you must be a new applicant and apply after the #) th of ? SdJZ 2014, or have a current offer but not yet accepted.

- » Bachelor of Computer Science
- » Bachelor of Software Engineering
- » Bachelor of Information Technology
- » Bachelor of Technology (Computing Studies)
- » Master of Computer Science
- » Master of Information Technology

You must also:

- » be an international student
- » not be a citizen or permanent resident of Australia or New Zealand
- » be enrolling at the RMIT School of Computer Science and IT for the first time at your intended level of study (i.e. undergraduate or postgraduate) in Semester \$ in 2014
- » be planning to study for at least four semesters (for undergraduate students) and three semesters (for postgraduate students)
- » have achieved excellent results in your previous studies
- » pass a minimum requirement of a GPA 3.2 or 75% in previous studies
- » be a new applicant and apply after 17 March 2014.
- » have a current offer but not yet accepted.

Deferring your scholarship

Scholarships can be deferred to 2015, however the scholarship amount will be reverted to \$3000.

HOW TO APPLY

1) Students will be considered for eligibility at the time of application.
