## Application Information

### How to apply for this scholarship

To apply for this scholarship, you must:

1. **check that you are eligible to apply, enrolled in your 2014 courses and that the enrolment information is accurate**
2. **complete the online application**
  - **the online application link will be available on the scholarship webpage on 5 May 2014**
  - **scholarship questions in the application will be:**
    - Describe your capability in demonstrating high academic performance. (up to 200 words)
    - Outline your academic performance in the Bachelor of Business (Entrepreneurship) (BBE) program. (up to 200 words)
    - Describe how you have contributed to the BBE program in regards to leadership and teamwork (up to 250 words)
    - Describe details of entrepreneurial activities you have been involved in while enrolled in the BBE program. (up to 250 words)
    - Describe your ability to represent the BBE program and RMIT University in an outstanding manner. (up to 250 words)
    - Describe why and what you expect to achieve from attending the annual Collegiate Entrepreneurship Organization Conference in the USA this year. (up to 250 words)
3. **submit supporting documentation along with the Supporting Documentation Submission Page (page 2 of this document) only if:**
  - **you have exceptional circumstances for studying part time, and/or**
  - **you have received credit for your studies from another institute that counts towards your current RMIT program you must provide a copy of your transcript of results.**

Multiple and partially complete applications will not be considered; only your first online application will be assessed.

Your application and supporting documentation must be submitted by **4pm, Friday 23 May 2014**. Late applications will not be assessed.
